

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE Wednesday – 31st October 2018

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 880 Cattle consisting of 508 Prime Cattle and 372 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 111 Bullocks, 26 Heifers, 259 Cows and 112 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 191 Steers, 165 Heifers and 16 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of mixed lines with a few pens of well finished cattle. The yarding was drawn from Cloncurry, Georgetown, Einasleigh, Julatten and local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Bullocks were quoted 10¢ dearer and Heifers were 20¢ dearer. Cows remained the same and Bulls were 20¢ dearer on last week's rates.
