MALANDA STORE SALE

Saturday 25th February 2023

Queensland Rural yarded a total of 182 Store Cattle. 84 Steers, 90 Heifers and 8 Mickeys.

The first Malanda Store Sale for 2023 saw continuing wet weather which resulted in a reduced yarding, however the market was still competitive with last year's prices.

Cattle comprised of high quality lines of Crossbred and Brahman Cattle. The yarding was drawn from many Local Coastal and Tableland areas such as Millaa Millaa, Ravenshoe, Tarzali, Malanda, Atherton, Mt Garnet and as far as Georgetown.
