Sale Report With another rain affected yarding, agents offered 1200 cattle at today's Emerald Sale. While quality was fairly mixed, the market held stable throughout most sectors, some of the cows & prime heifers increased by up to 20c/kg. Feeder steers softened from 3-5c/kg, while mid-range steers returning to the paddock, were slightly dearer than the previous week.

In the prime sector this week there were no Bullocks to quote on. Heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 318c/kg to average 298c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 280c/kg to average 267c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 279c/kg to average 262c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 287c/kg.

In the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgs sold to 334c/kg to average 308c/kg, 350-400kg steers topped at 364c/kg to average 307c/kg, 280-350kg steers made as much as 402c/kg to average 305c/kg, 200-280kg weaner steers reached 432c/kg to average 342c/kg, while there were no light steers under 200kgs to quote. Trade feeder heifers 350-400kgs sold to 280c/kg to average 256c/kg, 280-350kg heifers topped at 298c/kg to average 264c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 298c/kg to average 269c/kg, while weaner heifers under 200kg's made out to 270c/kg, to average 265c/kg.
