Sale Report Agents at Emerald yarded 2,270 head in a generally high-quality offering. Following the cancellation of last week's sale and weather disruptions over the previous fortnight, the prime cattle market remained stable to slightly softer. Store categories, however, trended firm to dearer, with weaner cattle recording notable gains of 10 to 30 cents per kilogram better.

In the prime section bullocks over 550kgs sold to 354c/kg to average 345c/kg, heavy steers 500-550kgs coming under slaughter & feeder competition reached 354c/kg to average 347c/kg, heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 337c/kg to average 317c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 298c/kg to average 286c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 287c/kg to average 276c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 285c/kg

In the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgs sold to 380c/kg to average 340c/kg, 350-400kg steers topped at 424c/kg to average 346c/kg, 280-350kg steers made as much as 474c/kg to average 373c/kg, 200-280kg weaner steers reached 488c/kg to average 432c/kg, while there were no light steers under 200kgs to quote. Trade feeder heifers 350-400kgs sold to 346c/kg to average 320c/kg, 280-350kg heifers topped at 374c/kg to average 317c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 354c/kg to average 299c/kg, while too few light heifers under 200kgs to
