Sale Report With another rain affected yarding, agents offered 900 cattle at today's Emerald Sale. With recent rainfall across the state disrupting supply, this brought a positive edge to values, with slaughter descriptions gaining 20-25 c/kg, while the guality of the store cattle offered was fairly mixed, most categories lifted by 10-15c/kg, particularly feeder heifers.

Bullocks over 500kg made to 364c/kg to average 357c/kg. Heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 347c/kg to average 318c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 306c/kg to average 287c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 296c/kg to average 271c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 288c/kg. In the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgs sold to 342c/kg to average 328c/kg, 350-400kg steers topped at 380c/kg to average 369c/kg, 280-350kg steers made as much as 394c/kg to average 364c/kg, 200-280kg weaner steers reached 381c/kg to average 330c/kg, while there were no light steers under 200kgs to quote. Trade feeder heifers 350-400kgs sold to 315c/kg to average 299c/kg, 280-350kg heifers topped at 308c/kg to average 290c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 332c/kg to average 282c/kg, while there were no heifers under 200kg's to quote.

Sale Highlights: Les & Carmen Stewart 'Terang' Comet sold Brangus Bullocks to 353kg and weighed 724kg or \$2557, while the Prince Family 'Melaleuca' Capella sold Droughtmaster Steers to 340c/kg and weighed 449kg to return \$1527. The Sparrow Family 'Malden' Alpha sold Droughtmaster Cows to 295c/kg and weighed 508kg to make \$1500 per head, while Dozer & Chyanne Loudon 'Karinda' Springsure sold Charolais Cross Cows to 302c/kg to weigh 585kg or \$1767. Stuart & Di Jeppesen 'Olivevale' Comet sold Charolais Cross Cows to 298c/kg to weigh 627kg to return \$1869, while the Randell Family 'Crinum' Tieri sold Brahman Heifers to 314c/kg and weighed 402kg or \$1263. Lyn Sypher 'West Park' Emerald sold a line of Droughtmaster Cows to 306c/kg and weighed 620kg and returned at \$1898.
