Sale Report Emerald agents yarded an increased total of 1,080 head, with numbers up on the previous week. The yarding was of mixed quality, reflecting a notable rise in store cattle entering the market. The prime market held firm, with solid demand from processors across both first-and second-grade descriptions. The store section offered several well-presented lines, and strong buyer competition throughout the day resulted in upward movement in the trade feeder steer market with other categories staying stable to slightly firmer. In the prime section there were not enough steers in weight range over 500kgs to quote on, heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 304c/kg to average 277c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 274c/kg to average 263c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 271c/kg to average 253c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 270c/kg. with what was on offer in the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgs sold to 376c/kg to average 328c/kg, Steers 350-400kg sold to 388c/kg to average 346c/kg. Steers 200-280kgs sold to 454c/kg to average 436c/kg. Heifers 350-400kg's sold to 314c/kg to average 289c/kg, while Heifers 280-350kg's sold to 316c/kg to average 276c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 348c/kg to average 295c/kg, while too few light heifers under 200kgs to quote. This week there were no cows and calves to quote on.
