MAREEBA COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Tuesday 5th August 2025

Mareeba Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,062 Prime & Store Cattle this week. Prime cattle saw an upward trend this week, following improvements in southern markets. Isolated pens of well-finished bullocks made up to 40 cents more than last week. Larger runs of well-finished cows were on offer, trading 20–30 cents dearer, while isolated pens of heavy bulls remained firm.

This week's store cattle yarding was dominated by larger lines of Brahman type Steers with a few isolated pens of flatbacks. The remainder of the yard consisted mainly of Northern type cattle. Across all categories, flatback cattle continued to attract strong buyer interest, consistently achieving prices at the upper end of the market.
