<u>Sale Report</u> Emerald Agents today yarded just under 1300 head what saw to be mainly a prime sale yarding on the back of Tuesday Weaner and Feeder sale. Prices in the slaughter categories eased slightly on the past months higher than usual rates with heavy cows back 12-15cents. Store categories experienced limited competition based on the small offering. Heavy bullocks still held ground with the best to 401c/kg for types 500kg and over, steers 400-500kg topped at 371c/kg and averaged 338 cents, while steers 400kg and less were too few to get a reliable price guide. Heavy heifers topped at 390c/kg and averaged 340 cents, with 350-400kg making to 366c/kg and averaged 316 cents, heifers 280-350kg topped at 350 cents to averaged 322 cents, while heifers 280kg and less were too few to reliably quote. Heavy Cows 520kg plus topped at 370 cents and averaged 323 cents, while cows 450-520kg topped at 360 cents and averaged 288 cents. a small pen of cows and calves topped at \$1475 per unit.
