## MAREEBA COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

## Tuesday 26th August 2025

A total of 791 head were yarded this week by the Mareeba Combined Agents. The sale drew strong competition, with both local and southern processors in attendance. Most quality lines showed improvement across all categories. This resulted in stronger prices, particularly for well-finished Cattle, reflecting confidence in the current market.

The Store market remained strong this week, with increased demand pushing prices higher across the board. Quality flatback Steers reached a top of 408 cents/kg. Good soft Heifers also performed well, topping at 318 cents/kg. Overall, all store Steers and Heifers were dearer this week, driven by competitive bidding and strong restocker interest.
