MAREEBA COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Tuesday 30th September 2025

A total of 487 head were yarded this week by the Mareeba Combined Agents. Prime cattle prices eased slightly compared to last week, with the majority of the yarding comprising Northern cattle. Cows reached a top of 298 c/kg, the better end of the Steers topped at 360 c/kg and Bulls remained firm, achieving a top price of 340 c/kg.
