CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME SALE Wednesday - 5th November 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,477 Prime cattle consisting of 317 Bullocks, 309 Heifers, 722 Cows and 129 Bulls.

Cattle comprised of isolated pens of meat works Bullocks, one good line of spayed Trade Heifers, only a few pens of heavy weight Cows, with the majority being light Cows. The yarding was drawn from Burketown, Richmond, Hughenden, Chillagoe, Georgetown, Basalt as well as local and coastal areas.

<u>Prime Quotes</u>: Bullocks were quoted 20¢ dearer, Heifers were 10¢ dearer, Cows were 20¢ dearer, and Bulls were unchanged on last week's rates.
