CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS STORE SALE

Friday - 7th November 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,425 Store Cattle. The Store Cattle consisted of 1,016 Steers, 36 Mickeys, 1,355 Heifers and 18 x 18 Cows & Calves.

Store cattle were mostly made up of younger types, with majority of the yarding showing the signs of the season. Heavier, better-quality runs of store cattle were met with strong competition. Heavy feeder types were few in supply and were met with strong demand.

The yarding was drawn from Burketown, Georgetown, Mt Surprise, Chillagoe, Prairie as well as local and coastal areas.

- Cows & Calves sold from \$550 to \$1,450 per unit.
