Sale Report: Emerald agents yarded a reduced offering of 1,000 head in a mixed-quality yarding. With limited numbers of heavy cattle on offer, there was strong competition across all slaughter descriptions — particularly in the cow sector, which averaged 10 to 20 cents a kilo dearer on last week. Other prime categories were mostly firm to slightly stronger, while the store section, made up of very mixed-quality cattle, held mostly steady to a touch easier in places.

In the prime section bullocks over 550kgs sold to 425c/kg to average 417c/kg, while heavy steers 500-550kgs sold to 420c/kg to average 415c/kg, heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 400/kg to average 371c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 387c/kg to average 365c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 384c/kg to average 336c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 366c/kg.

In the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgs sold to 417c/kg to average 374c/kg, 350-400kg steers topped at 460c/kg to average 414c/kg, 280-350kg steers made as much as 452c/kg to average 404c/kg, 200-280kg weaner steers reached 486c/kg to average 414c/kg, while there were only few steers under 200kg to quote on, Trade feeder heifers 350-400kgs sold to 388c/kg to average 335c/kg, 280-350kg heifers topped at 380c/kg to average 345c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 358c/kg to average 290c/kg, while Heifers under 200kgs made to 330c/kg to average 278c/kg.
