

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 8th July, 2026

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,799 cattle, consisting of 1,251 prime cattle & 548 store cattle. The prime cattle consisted of 300 Bullocks, 183 Heifers, 711 Cows and 57 Bulls. The store section consisted of 289 Steers, 85 Mickeys, 158 Heifers and 16 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of isolated pens of meatworks cattle with most lines being lightweight and plainer Cows. All usual operators competed in a dearer market. The yarding was drawn from Julia Creek, Richmond, Einasleigh, Georgetown, Burketown and Mt Isa as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted 10¢ dearer, Heifers were 5¢ dearer, Cows were 20¢ dearer, and Bulls were 20¢ dearer on last week's rates.

- The top pen of Cows were sold by A/c Mary Jane Johnston for 354¢/kg, weighing 578kg to return \$2,047 per head.
- Bulls sold on A/c Cooida Grazing P/L topped at 368¢/kg and weighed 646kg, to return \$2,381 per head.
