

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 15th July, 2026

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,401 cattle, consisting of 1,659 prime cattle & 742 store cattle. The prime cattle consisted of 308 Bullocks, 383 Heifers, 911 Cows and 57 Bulls. The store section consisted of 573 Steers, 158 Heifers and 11 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of a few pens of well-finished Bullocks selling to strong competition with mixed lines of well-finished Heifers and Cows also selling to good competition. The yarding was drawn from Camooweal, Mount Isa, Burketown, Richmond, Hughenden, Cape York, Mount Garnet, Einasleigh, Georgetown, as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted 10¢ easier, Heifers were 5¢ dearer, Cows were 10¢ dearer and Bulls were 10¢ dearer on last week's rates.

- Bullocks topped at 372¢/kg for a pen of 13 sold on A/c P & L Fry, that weighed 660kg to return \$2,459 per head.
- Best priced Trade Heifers were presented on A/c V McMahon that sold for 360¢/kg and weighed 530kg to return \$1,908 per head.
- The top pen of cows were sold by Brown & Sons for 360¢/kg weighing 508kg to return \$1,833 per head.
- Bulls sold on A/c EJT & KL Camp topped at 348¢/kg and weighed 645kg to return \$2,248 per head.

Store Quotes: Store cattle were made up of minimal pens of feeder Steers and Heifers, selling to strong demand with a lot more lighter weight Steers and Heifers heading back to the paddock.
