

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 26th August, 2026

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,853 Cattle, consisting of 1,262 Prime Cattle and 591 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 600 Bullocks, 198 Heifers, 312 Cows, and 152 Bulls. The Store Cattle consisted of 437 Steers, 18 Mickeys, 143 Heifers, and 11 Cows and Calves.

The yarding featured good-quality bullocks and trade-weight heifers, with isolated pens of processor heifers. There were fewer cows on offer; however, some good-quality pens of heavy cows were presented, along with pens of slaughter bulls and quality export bulls. Cattle were drawn from Hughenden, Georgetown, Einasleigh, Forsayth, Ingham, Torrens Creek, and local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted unchanged, Heifers were 10¢ easier, Cows were 5¢ easier, and Bulls were firm on last week's rates.

- Bulls sold on A/c Dreghorn Cattle Co topped at 366.2¢/kg and weighed 800kg, to return \$2,929 per head.
